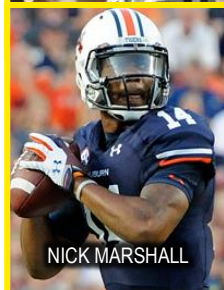

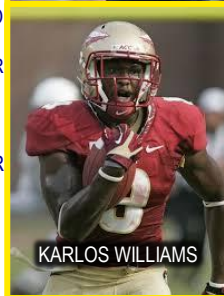

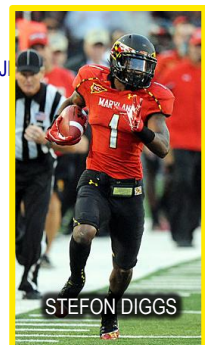

I rank as many players nationwide as I can. I rank each player on their skills at their position. I do not rank players based ENTIRELY on stats, (that does not mean that stats are not a factor in ranking the players above) that is unfair to that player and the other players being ranked. If a player threw for 5,000 plus yards a season ago and is not found in the top five quarterbacks for this season do not be surprised, but some players in the top five may have had very productive numbers and are more deserving of that ranking than others. I wanted to get this across before I get questions about why isn't this player ranked ahead of this player when this player threw for 350 more yards.

Even though a player may be ranked in the top four or so of their given position, that does not necessarily mean that that player will be on one of my four All-American teams. Most All-American teams (mine included) are based mostly on stats and the production of a player from week one to the final game. That doesn't mean someone who throws for 5,000 yards is going to be first team All-America but they may have a better shot at being on the team as opposed to a better quarterback who barely passed for 2,000 yards.

*Player rankings are completed in May. So, if a player was injured or had left the team after May he may still be listed.

*I do not rank true freshmen and rarely will you see a redshirt freshman listed on my player rankings.

*I do rank players that were injured in the spring that could possibly not play in the fall. So, some of the players listed may not be in uniform for the majority of the season.

*Many players are subject to change positions from the period of spring to summer. (Most commonly in offensive linemen and defensive backs)
